CADET OCEAN LIFEGUARD TRAINING PROGRAM

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Age:** 15 years of age as of April 1, 2010
- Medical:** A physical examination will be administered to all applicants. The basic examination will include a drug and alcohol test. The vision requirement is 20-40 correctable in an aquatic environment. These standards are extremely high because Cadet Ocean Lifeguards work in the interest of public safety.
- Background:** A background check requiring fingerprinting will be conducted (a signed Parental Consent Form is Required for those under 18 years of age). Applicants possessing a California driver's license will also undergo a DMV check.
- Citizenship:** All employment offers are contingent upon establishing proof of individual's legal right to work in the United States as required by the Immigration Reform and Control Act.

TO BE SELECTED FOR THE TRAINING PROGRAM YOU MUST SUCCESSFULLY PASS THE FOLLOWING PROCESS:

A Cadet Ocean Lifeguard competitive test will be conducted on **Sunday, June 6, 2010**.

The test will begin at Lifeguard Headquarters located at the base of the Newport Pier. Metered parking is available.

CHECK-IN IS REQUIRED BY 8:30 AM (YOU MUST HAVE PICTURE IDENTIFICATION TO CHECK-IN).

This is a competitive test and all applicants must complete the following requirements to qualify for the Cadet Ocean Lifeguard Training Program. A combined point total of these two physical tests will determine eligibility for the 2010 training program. (Physical events may be modified for safety). *There are 20 Cadet Positions available.*

1. 1,000 meter ocean swim
2. 1,000 meter ocean run-swim-run

Those who become eligible for the training program will be notified June 6, 2010. Applicants will be required to begin the City application process. Applicants will not be hired until this process is completed. Cadets will be compensated at minimum wage during the training program.

CADET TRAINING SCHEDULE: Your attendance in training is **MANDATORY!** Be sure to check in advance for any conflicting dates.

June 30 - August 12, 2010 (Cadets are scheduled to work Monday -Thursday)
Monday - Wednesday 10:30 AM – 3:30 PM
Thursday 9 AM - 12 PM or 1 PM - 4 PM (Junior Lifeguard Assistants)

HIRING PROCEDURE: Cadets will be hired based on their performance during the test on June 6, 2010

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE: Registration and Waiver forms are available at Lifeguard Headquarters located at the base of Newport Pier or online at www.newportlifeguard.org or www.newportbeachca.gov

FILING DEADLINE: Registration and Waiver forms must be received at the Lifeguard Headquarters on the Newport Pier by 5 pm, June 2, 2010. **NO LATE FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** If you have any questions, call (949) 644-3170.
